01 Assess

You will be shown 4 situation descriptions for each topic. Choose the situation description that best represents your organisation. You will assess a total of 9 organisational areas which are important for the Europeanisation of your organisation.



02 Evaluate

You will receive an evaluation of your organisation. You will, therefore, be able to see how your organisation is prepared for international work and where there is a need for improvement. You will receive individual recommendations for future action from each of the 9 organisational areas.



03 upgrade2europe

Develop a strategy for the Europeanisation of your organisation. To this end, use the recommendations for action created for you as a guide and benefit from the upgrade2europe materials with a variety of tools and videos to support you.

# Use our tool to measure your institutional readiness for international work

One of masterproducts of the upgrade2europe project is the Digital Self-Assessment Tool. It is the core, the building stone for all other project products. We are talking with Heike about the tool: why is it so special and what is the added value of using it.

## Heike, what is the purpose of the Digital Self-Assessment Tool?

The tool is designed to provide a quick overview of your organisation in terms of international activities in Europe. overview includes a number of tailor-made tips and suggestions on how to best continue development your towards internationalisation at the end of the evaluation. These suggestions are connected to the respective tools in the upgrade2europe which aims organisations looking to deep-dive into the process.

## What are the areas readiness that the tool is addressing and why exactly those ones?

The tool is addressing the following general areas of development: corporate governance, management and leadership, operations and resources, and European partnerships. Within those "domains", it tackles, among others, the issues of mission & vision, development analysis, management (risk management, quality control, project management etc.), leadership, personnel development, finances, communication.These topics everything that any organisation needs to keep in mind in order to kickstart their process of europeanisation. During the process of selfassessment, we provide suggestions and insights on each of those individual topics.

As such, the new upgrade2europe website will act as a one-stop-shop for everything regarding europeanisation: from initial analysis all the way to successful implementation.

# In what ways does it offer extra value to the users compared to other self-assessment tools?

Our analytical questions are designed for you to already learn a lot by just thinking about and filling out the questionnaire of the self-assessment tool. The different scenarios that illustrate the questions can be used as pinpoints to derive an idea of your own organisation's level of europeanisation. Everything, including the concluding analysis and tailor-made suggestions on how best to proceed with the process, will be provided free of charge.

#### To whom do you recommend using it?

We recommend upgrade2europe to small and medium organisations and enterprises, for example foundations, associations or training providers. However, the tool can also successfully be used by any other organisation, even if your organisation is already active on an international level or was part of an EU-project before!

# After completing the self-assessment, what are the next steps the user should do to be more successful at the international level?

The user should analyse and assess the tips and suggestions they received at the end of the self-assessment process.

Building on those, they should decide the next steps of optimisation and further development, decide on the respective tools and methods together with their team, and thus start the process of europeanisation.

#### Last, but not least, when will the tool be available and how?

The tools will be released step-by-step, starting soon with the self-assessment tool. By August, all six upgrade2europe products will be available in the online tool <a href="https://www.upgrade2europe.eu">www.upgrade2europe.eu</a>.
