





Sicilian fruit and vegetables are among the finest examples of Italian agricultural produce. Thanks to its many microclimates, Sicily produces high-quality citrus fruits, grapes, tomatoes and other vegetables and fruits, many of which have PDO certification (**Ribera Orange, Etna Prickly Pear, San Cono Prickly Pear, Siracusa Lemon and Bronte Green Pistachio**) and PGI certification (**Pachino Tomato, Sicilian Red Orange, Pantelleria Caper, Interdonato Lemon of Messina, Leonforte Peach, Canicatti Table Grapes, Mazzarrone Table Grapes and the New Carrot of Ispica**). As the focus on innovation and sustainability increases, Sicilian companies are expanding their presence in foreign markets.

Sicily has become the heart of Italy's tropical fruit production, particularly for avocados, mangoes, papayas, and lychees. Thanks to its mild climate and fertile soils, the island offers ideal conditions for these exotic crops, which blend perfectly into the Mediterranean agricultural landscape. Sicilian avocados, renowned for their quality and sustainable cultivation, are gaining popularity in both national and European markets. Local producers focus on low-impact farming techniques, short supply chains, and selected varieties to ensure a genuine and competitive product. "Made in Sicily" tropical fruit thus represents a new frontier for the region's agri-food sector, a symbol of innovation and climate adaptation.

In 2023, the value of agricultural exports from Latin America and the Caribbean exceeded **USD 30 billion**. The tropical fruit and vegetable sector alone generated a surplus of around USD 12.8 billion.
